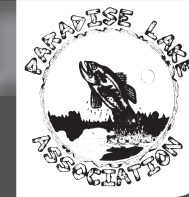
### When you leave a body of water:

- Drain water from equipment (boat, motor, trailer, live wells) before transporting.
- Clean and dry anything that comes into contact with water.
- Never release plants, fish or animals into a body of water unless they came out of that body of water.



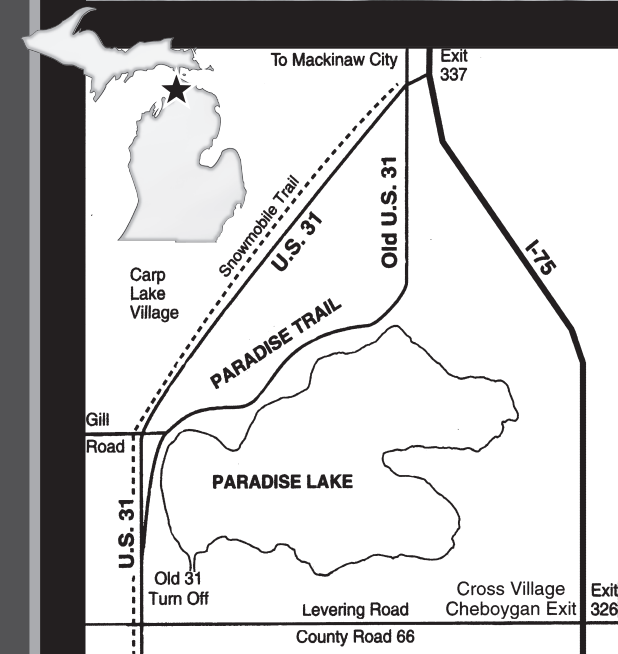
## Paradise Lake Pilot Boat Washing Station

The Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa (LTBB) Indians in collaboration with the Michigan DNR (MDNR) and the Paradise Lake Improvement Board (PLIB) was awarded a 2011 Great Lakes Restoration Initiative grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to construct a Paradise Lake Pilot Boat Washing Station at the MDNR public access site. A ribbon cutting ceremony on June 7, 2013 opened this facility. This project will focus on preventing the spread of invasive species to and from Paradise Lake.
